



Camp Nurse

Purpose

The main purposes of camp nurse at Pinecrest Baptist Bible Camp is to administer medication, tend to injuries/medical issues that develop at camp and to show a Christ like attitude.

Qualifications:

This person is to have current first aid and feel confident administering it. They should be a mature Christian in good standing with local church.

Responsibilities:

- Safely and securely store camper's medication and administer at proper times.
- Be present at registration to take meds and instructions from parents. Medication form provided to be filled out at this time.
- They must be able to be contacted at all times while serving at camp.
- Be present when waterfront activities occur.
- Responsible to the Camp Director.

Additional Information

Cell phones are to be used for camp business, and should only be used personally before the campers are awake or after the campers are in bed. Modest dress must be worn and encouraged as an example for the campers. Romantic relationships with campers are forbidden and romantic relationships with other staff are not encouraged so it does not become an impediment with the operation of the camp.

This is a volunteer position with room and board provided. Successful applicant will be required to submit a current 'Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Verification' and an 'Intervention Record Check'.
